

**Riverbank Traditional Pow Wow
Riverfront Park
Lansing, Michigan
June 18, 19, 20, 2010**

Dear Vendor,

The Native American Arts and Crafts Council is hosting the Riverbank Traditional Pow Wow on June 18, 19, 20, 2010 at Riverfront Park in Lansing, MI. This year, we will be limiting the number of vendors to 35. In addition to your application and fee, we ask that vendors send in 3 photos: 2 photos of their merchandise and 1 photos of their set up. Vendors at the Pow Wow in 2009 need not send in pictures. The deadline for applications is May 1, 2010. The committee will review all photos and applications after the May 1, 2010 deadline. Accepted vendors will be notified by email May 15, 2010.

Once again, craft and supply booths are asked not to sell any food items (ie soda pop, water, or candy) or else they will be asked to leave the event without a refund. In turn, invited food vendors will not be allowed to sell any craft or supply items. A limited number of spaces with electricity will be available for a \$25.00 weekend fee. The committee will assign space on a paid in full basis. Set up will be on Thursday, June 17, 2010 beginning at 4:00 pm. The Pow Wow will open to the public at 12:00 noon Friday. Once again we are having a community pot luck meal at 6:00 pm Friday night. Please plan on bringing a dish to pass and joining us.

We will have an auction at 5:30 pm Saturday. A donation from each vendor would be appreciated.

This year there will be absolutely no refunds of vendor fees. The Pow Wow Committee or City of Lansing will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Camping will be once again available in the north end of the park. Smaller camping setups can happen behind booths; however the pow wow committee reserves the right to limit the size of camping vehicle that will be placed there. If your camper or RV is longer than the required frontage of your booth, you will be asked to have your camper/RV be moved to the camping area. ***The City of Lansing has restricted the parking of any RV Motor home, bus, 5th wheel trailer, cargo trailer over 25 ft. on the circle. All of those vehicles must park in the campground.***

This Pow Wow is in cooperation with the City of Lansing, and will have free gate admission to the public. We will once again be looking forward to a good turnout.

All checks and money orders will be returned to those vendors not accepted. If you want photos returned, you must enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope. Once again, there will be no walk-in space available. Payment must be made in U.S. Dollars only. Make checks and money orders Payable to: **Native American Arts & Crafts Council**.
